

Dear Residents,

Due to the anticipated snowfall on Sunday, January 25, 2026, and in the interest of public safety, Mayor Michael F. Kohut has declared a Village of Haverstraw Snow Emergency, effective Sunday, January 25, 2026 at 6:00 a.m.

During this snow emergency, parking regulations will be strictly enforced on all Village streets during the storm and for up to 48 hours after the snow has stopped. Vehicles may be ticketed or towed. This is necessary to allow our Department of Public Works to safely and efficiently clear roadways and ensure emergency access throughout the Village.

Residents are strongly encouraged to remain indoors during the storm, limit travel unless absolutely necessary, and ensure they have adequate emergency supplies, including food, medications, and necessities for pets.

Our DPW crews are prepared and will be working diligently before, during, and after the storm to keep our roads safe. We appreciate your cooperation and patience as they carry out this important work.
